

Resident Doctors of BC ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE POLICY

Updated April 23, 2015

Passed by Board Resolution 1154, on May 6, 2015

The objective of this policy is to establish a protocol for the responsible consumption of alcohol at Resident Doctors of BC events. This policy applies to all organizers, attendees, including Board Members, and staff.

Event management guidelines:

- Remind the attendees of their obligations under this policy as guests of Resident Doctors of BC;
- Provide a selection of non-alcoholic beverages as alternatives to alcoholic beverages;
- When possible, arrange for drink tickets at events, and provide up to two alcohol tickets per guest;
- As Resident Doctors of BC opposes the operation of a vehicle or engaging in other inherently dangerous activities while impaired, we encourage the use of taxis & public transit at events;
- Resident Doctors of BC staff will document any actions, which a Resident Doctors of BC staff member takes in response to dealing with an impaired event attendee, and report to the Board of Directors for review, and action, if required.
- Resident Doctors of BC reserves the right to ban from future events any impaired attendee who behaves in a dangerous or inappropriate manner
